Personal Experiences:

Delaware Ghost Hunters had started the investigation on the lower floor (meeting area). Everyone heard what sounded to be a heavy drop upstairs. When meeting with UFSJ, they stated that they were on the third floor and they didn't hear anything similar to what we heard. They also confirmed they did not drop anything while upstairs.

Investigator Jo Wilkins audibly heard a sigh from an unknown source in the General Store area. Also captured on recorder. Upstairs above the General Store, Jo heard what sounded to be a woman speaking, but could not make out the words. Steve and Jacob from UFSJ also heard similar at a separate time in the same area without knowledge of Jo's experience.

Second Floor above the General Store DGH was doing EVP (Electronic Voice Phenomena) work and Lead Investigator saw what appeared to be an apparition standing next to Chris Driscoll (client). The lady appeared to be standing in a dress with her arms behind her back and seemed to be in mere observance of what was going on. She appeared to have dark hair which was pulled back into a bun. Appearance occurred too swiftly to catch any other significant details.

Kitchen Area. Investigator Jason and Dan were conducting EVP work in the HVAC area off of the kitchen and experienced a significant drop in temperature as experienced by "cold chills" (left section, right corner). DGH searched for a source that could have led to the cold spot, but nothing led us to believe it was from a natural source.

Electronic Voice Phenomena:

Six EVP's were captured on audio while investigating the Paper Mill House Museum.

EVP1_f1_pm - *"We are the men"* - Male

EVP2_pmill_kitchen - DGH was investigating the kitchen area (HVAC), discussing the old whisey bottles when a male EVP states *"Yeah, Will you come with me?"*, followed by a possible elderly woman stating *"There's no crying..."*

EVP3_kitchen_pmill - Unintelligible EVP

EVP4_lowerfloor_comehere - *"See it."*

EVP5_2fl_yes_PM - Investigator asks question, then the response sounds like *"Yes."*

EVP6_genstore_PM - Appears to be a male EVP , *"On the table."*

Video/Photographic Anomalies:

No significant Video or Photograph.

Current Status:

Definately the possibility of being inhabited by an "intelligent" female spirit (as concluded through Visual and Audio)*. Old woman and male seem to be residual energy (energy left behind from past events).

*An intelligent spirit is one that is aware of his/her current surroundings.
